This year there are multiple ways to get involved in ATFS. Some examples are listed below but feel free to get creative, make suggestions and speak with me directly if you are interested in any kind of volunteering...

- ☑ Hindi Classes – Be a Hindi teacher
- ☑ Share a skill that you have with the children. Suggest one day of the week or month where you would like to come in for an hour and work with the children with any kind of hobby skill that you might have.
- ☑ Share your professional skills with the children. You could give lecture, a demonstration, a hands on experience or even an talk about professional adventures once a month or may be just once in the year
- ☑ Share your time with ATFS children. You can come in once a week and help with homework assistance at a one on one level as a teacher aid.
- ☑ Help out with web development – any enhancement such as online enrollment or parent groups etc.
- ☑ Technical consultant – help out with technical questions such as why our website does not scroll to the bottom of the page with some browsers etc.
- ☑ Come and teach computers to the children – think of some fun assignments and work with children to develop presentations
- ☑ Speech and debate – work with children once a month or more to assign topics and events for public speaking
