

ATFS Rewards Program

ATFS Semesters

ATFS follows annual system. An updated copy of the curriculum is released before the start of each session. The grade level topics are decided at the beginning of each year. At the end of each year, all scores are calculated and rewards announced. Successful completion of the topic means that all ATFS materials assigned have been completed and evaluated. All rewards are given in one ceremony at the end of an academic year in June.

Session Details

Months: **September to June**

Last Date for enrollment and fees: **Aug 20th**

Last Date to submit all completed books: **July 15th**

Please note our enrollment dates. We expect all deadlines to be respected. This ensures quality and commitment from our side as well. New enrollments may take place at any time during the session but will need to be for the remaining session.

ATFS Rewards

Eligibility

ATFS Learning Center rewards the kids for their achievements and performances. Children enrolled for the full time After School Program, part time (at least 3 days per week) after school program, Remote Learning or the Accelerated Learning Programs are eligible for it. Private Tutoring students and high school (Level 4) students are not eligible for any rewards. We follow an annual system and "take out" children need to be enrolled for the whole year. They may switch from one program to another within the year if the situation warrants. This switch will need to be approved by the director. Registration fee will apply at the time of any program switch.

Timely completion of assigned workbooks qualifies them for a reward in those topics. Children can do a maximum of 10 topics within a year. All ASL and AL students can have a maximum of 10 topics only during a year unless they choose to go with a hybrid program.

A child will be awarded a medal and a certificate for each subject based on the criteria below. The aggregate percentages will be calculated at the end of each academic year. All completed books will contribute to the final percentage. Math monthly test scores will contribute 50% of the Math score. Monthly spelling tests will contribute 50% of the spelling score.

Math (aggregate percentage)

95.1% - 100.00 % - trophy and a certificate (honor roll)

90.1% - 95.00% - Gold Medal and a certificate

85.1% - 90.00% - Silver Medal and a certificate

80.1% - 85.00% - Bronze medal and a Certificate

Reading, Science Language arts and Spelling (aggregate percentage)

95.1% - 100.00 % - trophy and a certificate (honor roll)

90.1% - 95.00% - Gold Medal and a certificate

80.1% - 90.0% - Silver medal and certificate

70.1% - 80.0% - Bronze medal and certificate

Books completed (eligibility)

Math: Children are entitled to a book a month. Minimum 8 out of a maximum 10 Math books must be completed during the 10 month session each year to be eligible for the Math award. For those who join in late, 80% of the books out of total enrolled months must be completed.

Reading and Science : Children will be required to complete a book over maximum of two months. That entitles them to at most 5 reading comprehension books during the 10 month period. Children who are able to complete at least 4 books will be eligible for an award in Reading. For those joining late, eligibility will be calculated based on prorating to 80%.

Spelling and Language Arts: Children will be required to complete a book over maximum of three months. That entitles them to at most 4 spelling books during the 10 month period. Children who are able to complete at least 3 books will be eligible for an award in spelling. For those joining late, eligibility will be calculated based on prorating to 80%.

ATFS holds a prize distribution ceremony at the end of each year (June) to encourage the children.

ATFS specific Policy for Rewards qualification of "Take Out" students

1. Children are required to do some sheets each day and plan to finish the assigned workbook within the due date listed on the cover of the workbook.
2. Parents are required to drop off or mail workbooks for correction at the ATFS center each week or month before the due date.
4. All students are expected to be honest and sincere towards their work.
